

We are looking for
a person with refugee background
for a Voluntary Social Year (FSJ) in politics
beginning from 1st September 2017
at the Green Parliamentary Group of Lower-Saxony.

We are offering a person with refugee background the possibility to get to know the work of a parliamentary group and to participate in it. This will happen within the scope of a Voluntary Social Year in politics which is going to start on September 1st in 2017.

Here you can get to know

- how politics work in a state parliament
- the essence of green politics
- what a parliamentary group is and how it works
- how laws evolve
- how political communication works
- how to organise events

For about one year you can work with us at the parliamentary group. Another young person is going to do his or her Voluntary Social Year in our fraction as well. You will work together by helping us and for example by supporting us with organizing events. You can join our green parliamentarians and get to know their political work. And you can work on topics that are discussed at the parliament.

You have to meet the following requirements:

- refugee background and aged between 18 and 26
- located in Germany since a minimum of three months
- in possession of a residence permit

German language skills are an advantage.

The Voluntary Social Year lasts from 1st September 2017 to 31st August 2018. The regular working time is at least 32 hours a week. We pay for the social insurance as well as 320 Euro (pocket money) for 38,5 weekly hours of work. This pocket money will be deducted from the compensation of the Asylum Seekers' Benefits Act (Asylbewerberleistungsgesetz).

We are a great team and are looking forward to your applications.
